BARREL FITTING INSTRUCTIONS

Because there are many different brands of 10/22[®] receivers on the market, we have intentionally left the barrel tenon slightly oversized so that it can be sanded to fit your specific receiver and give you the best foundation for accuracy. Ideally, your barrel tenon should interfere with the barrel bore by .0002-.0005" to provide a tight fit. The following instructions describe the process of fitting your barrel to your specific receiver. Use caution when fitting your barrel to your receiver, we recommend checking often to ensure that too much material hasn't been removed.

- 1. BEFORE BEGINNING ANY WORK ON A FIREARM, ENSURE THAT IT IS UNLOADED!
- 2. Double check step 1
- **3.** Try fitting the Summit Precision barrel into your receiver (we recommend using a small amount of anti-seize compound or grease to assist). Don't twist the barrel back and forth, it should go on straight with very little interference. You can use a nylon hammer to tap the back of the receiver.
- 4. If your barrel is too tight, use the included sand paper strips to remove a small amount of material from the barrel tenon and then test again. Take care to remove material evenly from the entire diameter.
- Check often to make sure you don't remove too much material, and take care that you don't taper the tenon by applying uneven pressure on the sandpaper.
- 6. Once the barrel can be installed with minimal interference, tap it into place to make sure it is fully seated to the receiver. Also make sure that the angled cutout is level to the bottom of the receiver before reinstalling the V block and barrel screws.



- **7.** Tighten the barrel screws to the same torque and reinstall the barreled receiver in the stock.
